On March 24, 2009, at 4:00 pm, T. Spadaro from INFN - LNF will give a seminar entitled:

"New physics tests with the KLOE experiment"

Abstract

Recent results from the KLOE experiment provide state-of-the-art tests of new physics effects beyond the standard-model (SM) predictions. The KLOE measurements of the CKM parameter Vus, of the ratio Vus/Vud, and of the ratio of leptonic K decay widths Ke2/Km2 are presented, with some emphasis on the analysis techniques allowing systematic uncertainties to be pushed down to 1% level or better. The physics implications of the present results and the perspectives for further improvements after detector updates and a foreseen new data taking are discussed.
